
When COOKIE MONSTER


2 hours before his appointment COOKIE MONSTER was sent an SMS to confirm he is COVID safe. If COOKIE MONSTER didn't respond to our SMS, he will need to complete a questionaire before he comes into the waiting area. He will be asked if he or anyone he is with has a cough, sore throat or fever, or has been in contact with anyone who has tested positive to COVID 19. Safety is our NUMBER ONE priority for our team and our patients, if he answers YES to any of these questions we will ask him to come back when he is feeling better!





Just make sure everyone uses it IMMEDIATELY when you arrive.





And you still get to watch your favourite TV shows on our giant screens to keep you entertained.





Monster brought along his own so he could still enjoy creating a masterpiece to take home with him!




